**NOTICE OF PROPOSED PUBLIC SALE AND
NOTICE OF COMPENSATION OF AUCTIONEER**

Your rights may be affected. You should read these papers carefully and discuss them with your attorney, if you have one in this bankruptcy case. (If you do not have an attorney, you may wish to consult one.)

TO: ALL PARTIES IN INTEREST

Pursuant to 11 U.S.C. §363(b), Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure 6004, 2002 (a), and 2002 (c) (1), notice is hereby given that James B. Angell, Chapter 7 Trustee in the above referenced case ("Trustee") proposes to sell the following described property:

2 Victory two door refrigerators, 2 stainless steel sinks, hood, stainless steel racks, tables and chairs, 2 deep fryers, griddle and stove combo, cash register, stainless steel tables.

Notice is further given that the Trustee proposes to sell said property at the date, time and place as hereinafter set out:

The Trustee has filed an application with the court to approve the employment of Country Boys Auction as auctioneer whose compensation shall be fixed at a rate not to exceed the following:

Personal Property
20% on first \$20,000.00
10% on next \$50,000.00
4% on the balance

Real Property
10% on first \$25,000.00
4% on the balance

The auctioneer shall be reimbursed for all reasonable and necessary expenses of sale. Such compensation and reimbursement of expenses shall be subject to final review by the court, without further notice.

If you do not want the court to allow the sale and compensation, or if you want the court to consider your views on the sale and compensation, then on or before **April 30, 2009**, unless otherwise ordered, you or your attorney must file with the court, pursuant to Local Rule 9013-1 and 9014-1, a written response, an answer explaining your position, and a request for hearing.

Pursuant to that Memorandum from Chief Bankruptcy Judge J. Rich Leonard, EDNC, dated February 24, 2005, attorneys practicing in the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Eastern District of North Carolina, including attorneys admitted pro hac vice, are required to file electronically all documents [including new bankruptcy petitions, motions, memoranda of law, and other pleadings, but excluding proofs of claim and documents to be placed under seal in accordance with Local Bankruptcy Rule 5005-4(6)]. Any documents required to be filed electronically pursuant to Local Bankruptcy Rule 5005-4(1) but presented in paper form on or after April 1, 2005, shall be accompanied by an application for an exemption from this rule and a proposed order granting the relief sought. The application shall state the reason(s) why electronic filing would impose an extreme hardship on the attorney. Local Bankruptcy Rules pertaining to electronic filing, including Local Bankruptcy Rules 5005-4(1) and 5005-4(2) may be found on the Court's website www.nceb.uscourts.gov. If you mail your response to the court for filing, you must mail it early enough so the court will receive it on or before the date stated above.




