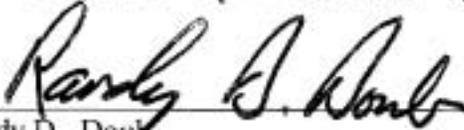
GENERAL ORDER

11 U.S.C. § 308, effective January 30, 2009, requires a small business debtor in a chapter 11 case to file periodic financial reports. Rule 2015(a)(6) of the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure, effective December 1, 2008, requires that the report be filed monthly on the appropriate Official Form, which is Official Form 25C. That form, effective December 1, 2008, requires the debtor to "attach a copy of your latest bank statement for every account you have as of the date of this financial report or had during the period covered by this report."

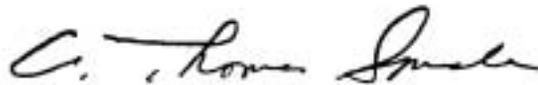
The bank statements that are required to be filed are likely to contain information that may be protected under 11 U.S.C. § 107(b)(1). To facilitate the protection of that information, the court will allow the bank statements to be filed separately, and, if a bank statement is filed separately, the clerk shall treat the filing of the bank statement as a private entry until further order of the court. The clerk's Administrative Guide shall reflect the procedure authorized by this order.
