## Mortgage Payment Changes

A supplemental proof of claim may be filed in bankruptcy cases to indicate that the debtor's mortgage payment has changed. All interested parties should be served with the claim. This process should be followed versus the filing of a notice of payment change on the docket.

## Amended Schedules

Amended schedules should not be filed as an attachment to another document. For example, you may file a Motion to Modify Plan and attach an amended schedule. The amended schedule must be filed separately in order to record applicable statistical data and prompt for payment of any necessary fee. The amended schedule should also be verified by the debtor(s).

## Email Addresses

It is not necessary to insert an email address when adding a creditor to a case. You, as the attorney, will be linked to the creditor, and your email address is included in your address. Therefore, it is not necessary to insert it into the creditor address.

## Exhibit Copies

Attorneys should bring sufficient copies of previously admitted exhibits to court hearings. There may be times when the judge or other parties do not have their copy with them and extra copies may be needed.

### QUESTIONS/ANSWERS:

**Q. I KNOW THAT SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBERS SHOULD NOT APPEAR ON PLEADINGS FILED WITH THE COURT. WHAT OTHER ITEMS SHOULD BE EXCLUDED?**

**A. ALL FILINGS WITH THE COURT INCLUDING ATTACHMENTS MUST COMPLY WITH FED. R. BANKR. P. 9037: SOCIAL SECURITY OR TAXPAYER-IDENTIFICATION NUMBERS; DATES OF BIRTH; NAMES OF MINOR CHILDREN; AND FINANCIAL ACCOUNT NUMBERS MAY NOT APPEAR, EXCEPT AS ALLOWED BY THE RULE.**

**Q. WHEN I AM DOCKETING AN EVENT TO CORRECT A DEFICIENCY NOTICE THAT HAS BEEN ISSUED BY THE COURT, IS IT PROPER TO REFERENCE THE DEFICIENCY NOTICE ITSELF OR THE DOCUMENT THAT I AM ACTUALLY CORRECTING?**

**A. YOU SHOULD REFERENCE THE DOCUMENT THAT IS BEING CORRECTED.**
