
GENERAL ORDER


Upon the entry of an order of dismissal in a chapter 13 case prior to a plan being confirmed, and unless other arrangements are made with the debtor for compensation, counsel for the debtor shall have 14 days from the entry of the order of dismissal within which to file an application for attorney fees ("Application"). The Application shall be served upon the debtor and the chapter 13 trustee, and those parties-in-interest shall have 14 days, including any days for mailing, to respond.

The chapter 13 trustee shall not make any disbursement until the 14 day period for filing the Application has expired. If an Application is timely filed, the trustee shall continue to hold the funds in trust and shall not make final disbursement until the court rules on the Application.
