ORDER SETTING 2021 HOLIDAY SCHEDULE

Federal law establishes public holidays for federal employees, including Thanksgiving Day, Christmas Day, and New Year's Day. These holidays are celebrated through closure of the Offices of the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Eastern District of North Carolina.

Thanksgiving Day will be observed on Thursday, November 25, 2021. In extended observance of this holiday, the court's offices will close at 1:00 p.m. on Wednesday, November 24, 2021, and will remain closed through Friday, November 26, 2021.

Christmas Day will be observed on Friday, December 24, 2021. In extended observance of this holiday, the court's offices will be closed on December 23, 2021.

New Year's Day will be observed on Friday, December 31, 2021. In extended observance of this holiday, the court's offices will be closed on December 30, 2021. Beginning on Monday, January 3, 2022, the court will resume normal business hours.
