Loan Modification Management

The EDNC announces the immediate suspension of new applications for participation in the Loan Modification Management (“LMM”) program.

Sealed Documents

An administrative order was entered on April 21, 2026, restricting electronic access to sealed documents, effective immediately. Sealed documents will continue to be filed in CM/ECF under existing procedures.

A party with the right to access a sealed document can still request a paper copy by contacting the Clerk's Office. Because sealed documents filed in CM/ECF will no longer be accessible or viewable electronically, service cannot be accomplished through CM/ECF. Parties will have to serve sealed documents by other appropriate means as provided by the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure or as otherwise provided by the court. The court will serve and notice sealed documents in paper by mail.

Updated Quarterly Fee Schedule

The Bankruptcy Administration Improvement Act of 2025, Pub. L. No. 119-76 (BAIA 2025), enacted on February 6, 2026, increased the fee percentage in bankruptcy cases with disbursements exceeding \$1,000,000 from 0.8% to 0.9% and otherwise extended the existing calculation of quarterly fees under BAIA 2020 for calendar quarters beginning April 1, 2026, through December 31, 2030, including pending cases. The following table displays the disbursement ranges and quarterly fees under the amended quarterly fee schedule for calendar quarters beginning April 1, 2026, through December 31, 2030.
