- For all shows scheduled to be produced by the North Carolina Theatre for the 2024 season,
 - o If you purchased ticket(s) to a show(s) **through Ticketmaster**, you may seek a refund **from Ticketmaster**.
 - o If you purchased ticket(s) <u>directly through the North Carolina Theatre</u>, either from the Theatre's website, or by purchasing a subscription, you will receive Notice of the Bankruptcy Case from the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Eastern District of North Carolina, which will outline the options available to you within the Bankruptcy Case. (These are likely Annual or Seasonal Subscribers)
 - If you purchased ticket(s) via ArchTics, you will receive Notice of the Bankruptcy Case from the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Eastern District of North Carolina, which will outline the options available to you within the Bankruptcy Case. (There are likely holders of Season Tickets)
- Continued Operations:
 - During the reorganization phase, The North Carolina Theatre plans to continue the day-to-day operations of the **NCT Conservatory**, which will continue its educational programming for beginners to pre-professionals in acting, dancing, and voice performance.
