ATTORNEY ADMISSION INFORMATION

- A. The requirements for admission to the Eastern District of North Carolina are fully explained in Local Civil Rule 83.1. An application is available at the Clerk's Office in any division or at www.nced.uscourts.gov. The application must be typed or printed legibly, fully completed, and signed with original signatures. The applicant must provide a North Carolina State Bar number.
- B. Each applicant must be sponsored by two attorneys who are admitted to the Court's bar and can attest to his/her good character. Applicants who are members of the bar of the Middle or Western Districts of North Carolina may submit a copy of the original certificate of admission to that Court or a certificate of good standing that has been issued within four months of the application, in lieu of sponsorship and being sworn.
- C. The complete application packet and \$218.00 admission fee may be delivered personally to the Clerk's Office or mailed to the U.S. District Court, P. O. Box 25670, Raleigh, North Carolina 27611. Applications are not accepted by e-mail or facsimile transmission.
- D. Payment of the admission fee can be made by check or money order payable to "Clerk, U.S. District Court." Cash, American Express, Discover, MasterCard, and Visa are accepted at the Clerk's Office for applications submitted in person.
- E. Applications are reviewed for eligibility in the order received. The Clerk's Office will send a confirmation e-mail to the applicant after processing the application and provide available dates to be sworn in.
- F. The applicant may not practice in this court until either being sworn by a U. S. District, Magistrate, or Bankruptcy Judge or submitting a certificate of good standing or a copy of the original certificate of admission from the Middle or Western Districts. After receiving notice of approval, the applicant must register for an admission ceremony, and the process is incomplete until the oath has been administered.
- G. The Clerk's Office will mail the certificate of admission to the attorney at the address provided on the application upon completion of the preceding paragraph.
- H. Attached to the application is a pro bono interest form, which helps the court pinpoint an area of interest a particular attorney might consider for pro bono work. Completing the form is not a requirement for admission, but allows an attorney to receive information about pro bono opportunities and to volunteer to assist parties who appear in this court without aid of counsel. Completing the form does not obligate an attorney to any assignment.
